The answer is the Late Spring of 2001. Carl Underhill, Genealogist for the Underhill Society, has been working for four years collecting family data, compiling it, and typing the information into photo quality form which will be sent to the printer after the editing is completed. In addition to the hundreds of hours Carl has spent on the Genealogy, he has been answering as many as five inquiries a week from both members and non-members seeking information about their families. Carl is a retired Military Officer and is now managing an H&R Block Office. He has had no Genealogy training and is relying almost entirely on Secondary Information (information he has received from family members) to complete the two volumes (approximately 1400 pages) of the Genealogy. Carl is a very detailed person and I am certain this issue will be equal in quality to previous editions. We are currently getting prices from publishers.
